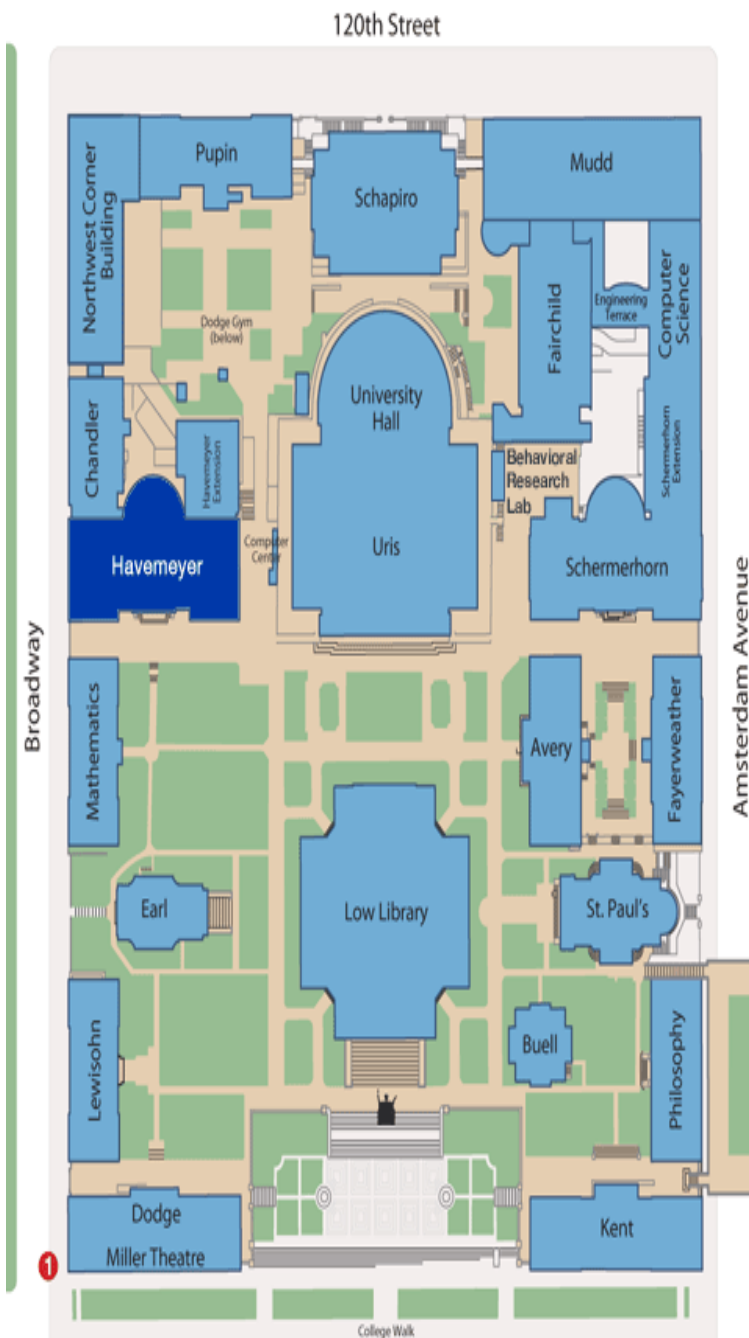

Directions to Havemeyer Hall

Built in 1897, Havemeyer Hall is the signature architectural feature of Charles Follen McKim's original design. Specifically, Room 309 Havemeyer has been featured prominently in a number of films, including Spiderman.



Getting to Columbia's Campus

The main entrances to Columbia's campus on Morningside Heights in Manhattan are at Broadway and 116th Street (where the #1 subway station is) and at Amsterdam Avenue and 116th Street.

Public Transportation:

The best way to reach campus is using the subway. Take subway line number 1 local to 116th Street (Columbia University) station.

Parking:

You may park on the street or use the local parking garages. The 512-520 Garage is located at the corner of 112th Street and Amsterdam; the Riverside Church Parking Garage is located on 120th Street between Claremont Avenue and Riverside Drive.

Finding Havemeyer Hall on Columbia's Campus

Havemeyer Hall is at the northern end of Columbia University's Morningside Campus.

Entering From Campus:

From the campus entrance, walk in along College Walk, head north up the steps, go around Low Library and turn left from Uris Hall (the Business School) to reach Havemeyer Hall. You will see the Columbia Lion statue in front of the building. Room 309 Havemeyer is located on campus level (3rd Floor).
